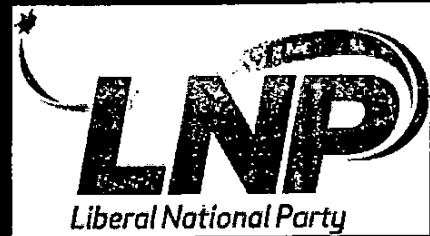

No. There should be thorough research of historical flood events prior to council building approvals.

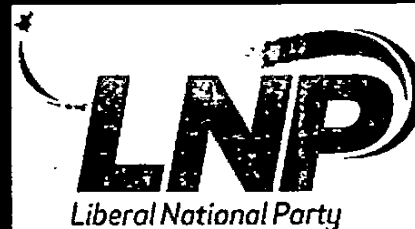
- Had you ever received evacuation information for flood / landslides / fires?
