My original submission was dated 6 March 2011

In view of the extraordinary circumstances which have precipitated further hearings, I seek to lodge a variation to my original submission based solely on issues raised in that submission.

In my original submission, I sought determination as to the impact of "*mismanagement/government interference/incompetence*" surrounding water releases. The scope of the extended enquiry seems to focus solely on those issues.

I have detailed the initial economic consequences of the flood. Obviously with the passage of time, the mental suffering has evidenced itself as well as the substantial loss in asset value of my property being deemed a *flooded property*.

In the event the Commission makes a determination that the flood was partly *man made*, I request that a determination be made as to the quantum by which the flood peak may have been reduced by the proper management of water releases.

This issue is of vital importance as I anticipate that any such reduction will mean my home no longer be flooded and could be considered as above the height of a properly managed flood the equivalent of the 2011 flood
