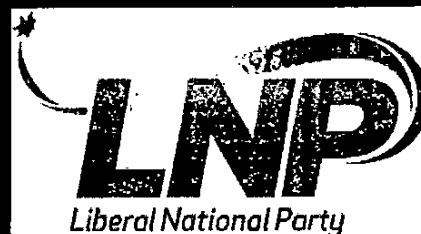

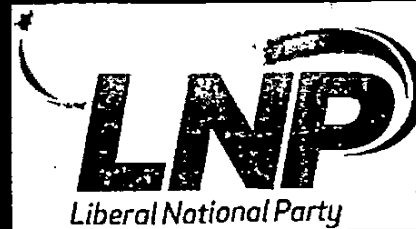

- After the flood *Creek crossing carrying a lot of traffic should be properly bridged to stop washing away*

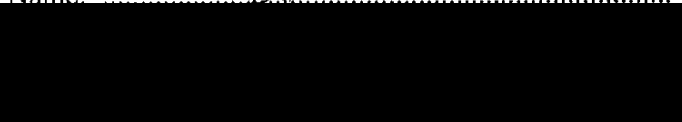
- Other Questions or Statements.
