STATEMENT OF PAUL FRANCIS HUGHES BIRD

On the 10th day of February 2012, I Paul Francis Hughes Bird, c/-240 Margaret Street, Brisbane, state on oath:

- I am Team Leader Corporate and Stakeholder Relations of the Queensland Bulk Water Supply Authority (Seqwater). At the time of the January 2011 floods, I was Senior Communication Advisor – Media and Ministerial of Seqwater.
- This statement is provided to the Queensland Floods Commission of Inquiry pursuant to a
 "Requirement to Provide Statement" issued to me by the Commission dated 9 February
 2012 (the *Requirement*). My best recollection of the matters set out in the Requirement,
 after reviewing my records, is set out below.
- I have no independent recollection of the teleconference held at 8.30am on 10 January
 2011. I participated in many meetings and teleconferences during that period.
- 4. I know that I took part in the teleconference because I have diary notes relating to it.
 Attached to this statement and marked PB-1 is a true copy of those diary notes. By way of explanation, my diary notes of the teleconference the subject of the Requirement begin at the line "8:00" and end at the line "3:00" on my diary page. The notes above the line "8:00" and below the line "3:00" on my diary page relate to other matters.
- 5. For assistance in interpreting my diary notes, attached to this statement and marked **PB-2** is a transcript of the relevant part of my diary note attached at PB-1, which I have prepared for the purposes of this statement. I have inserted comments in bracketed italics beside certain of my notes, which represent my interpretation of my diary notes after reading them.



- After reviewing my diary notes, my best recollection of the teleconference the subject of the Requirement is that:
 - (a) any discussion of release strategies was in terms of release volumes from Wivenhoe dam (that is, cubic metres per second); and
 - (b) there was no discussion involving the terms "W1", "W2", "W3" or "W4" at any stage during the teleconference.
- 7. I did not observe and was not aware of any other person taking notes of the teleconference.

3500/4000 in River - trying to keep to 3500 -

Aiming to release $3500m^3$ – currently at 2000 m³ – Depending on river – wanting to keep $3\frac{1}{2}$ - 4 in Brisbane River. (My notes on the expected release flow into the Brisbane River)

*If river level raises 3500 – BCC will say dam release contribute to urban flooding. (Do not recall who made this comment – note reflects that releases above 3500m³ will impact Moggill ferry & downstream)

/BALANCING INFLOWS / OUTFLOWS in line with Manual

- HOW MUCH NOTICE Before the change flows? (My note to question how long it takes for release to travel down the river? Do not recall if I actually asked the question or if it was a note to follow up later)

INFLOWS close to 9 – outflow @2.63 – GOOD JOB BEING DONE BY DAM (Note indicating how good a job the dam was doing in holding back the water.)

SOMERSET – Some facilities shut down (Some recreational areas closed due to water level) / Staff Access Landslides

LANDER SHUTE KENILWORTH 36 hours (No recall on this note)
