The engineers in the flood room make a number of decisions about appropriate releases and release strategy through the event. These decision are based on analysis such as inflows, projections of further inflows, estimates of affect of outflows considering DS levels, flows into the Brisbane from Lockyer and Bremer – determining the application of the manual to these circumstances. The review of this is part of the review of the consideration of the compliance with the manual question.

There will be the report on the event as is required under the manual in which the decisions and decision making process will be addressed. Your brief will include reviewing the report and the supporting information, including around these decisions.

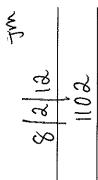
