- a flood, earthquake, seismic sea wave, cyclone, storm, tornado, eruption or other natural happening;
- an explosion, fire, gas leak, fuel or oil spill or any accident;
- an infestation, plague or epidemic;
- a failure of, or disruption to, an essential service or infrastructure; and
- an attack directed against the State.

Disaster District:

A portion of the state declared to be a Disaster District under the Disaster

Management Act 2003.

A Disaster District Coordinator appointed under the Disaster Management Act 2003.



1.20 COMMUNICATIONS

SITUATION REPORTS (Operational Reporting) [30(d)&(g)]

All response organisations are to submit regular situation reports to the LCC.

The Ghief Executive Officer is to collate reports received and supplies regular situation reports to the Disaster District Coordinator, Roma and the Area Director, CDR3, Roma.

WARNINGS - REPORT

- (a) Warnings of a natural disaster (e.g. storms, floods, etc) will be issued in the first instance by the Bureau of Meteorology to Local Controller.
- (b) In the event of a disaster for which a warning would not be issued by the Bureau of Meteorology, the designated Control Authority is to advise the Council.

WARNINGS - DISTRIBUTION

Under implementation of this plan all public warnings will be distributed through the LCC upon recommendation of the Control Authority and on the authorisation of the Chair of the LCDMG.

PUBLIC INFORMATION

The distribution, to the public, of contacts or telephone numbers for disaster information will be the responsibility of the Chair.

REQUESTS FOR EXTERNAL ASSISTANCE

- (a) Any requests for assistance from outside the Disaster Coordination Centre area are to be coordinated by the LGDMG.
- (b) Such requests are to be forwarded by the Chief Executive Officer to the District Disaster Coordinator, Roma, for action to the Area Director CDRS, Roma for information.

CONFERENCES - PROTRACTED OPERATIONS

Should damage or disruption be to such an extent that operations are to continue over a number of days the policy of daily meetings with Officers in Charge of Control and Support Organisations will be implemented for the purpose of coordinating effort and establishing priorities.

1.21 CONCLUSION OF OPERATIONS & DEBRIEF

(a) Acting on advice from the Control Authority the Chief Executive Officer is to coordinate a recall of participating organisations and close down the LCC.

(b) Members of participating organisations are to be debriefed by their respective Officers in

Charge prior to stand down.

(c) An operation debrief involving Officers in Charge of the Control Authority including the disaster coordination staff and the Support Organisations is to be conducted to the Chair within seven (7) days of completion of the operation.

1.22 PUBLIC EDUCATION & INFORMATION

GENERAL

Public Education and Public Information are two (2) separate functions within the context of the

PUBLIC EDUCATION

There is an ongoing public awareness program conducted by the Department of Emergency Services, the Media, and Balonne Shire Council through the LCDMG. Included in this program are the following:-

(a) Publications explaining disaster preparedness and emergency procedures;

(b) Preparation of media releases explaining disaster preparedness and emergency procedures:

(c) Publications prepared by statutory services detailing the measure that should be taken to prevent, minimise and deal with the effects of emergency situations.

(d) On going media campaign to encourage the public to "be aware".

PUBLIC INFORMATION

Public information is that information which is passed on to the public prior to, during, and after a disaster, such as warnings and directions. The Chair has the responsibility for the dissemination to the public of counter disaster information.

When this plan is activated the Chair is the official source of public and media information. All outside media inquiries are to be directed to the Chair.

MEDIA RELEASES

For other types of disasters, specific information relating to the disaster is to be released. This advice is to be provided by the Controlling Authority.

1.23 REVIEW & ASSESSMENT OF PLAN (Exercises) [59(1)(2)]


This Plan will be reviewed by the LGDMG on an annual basis with six monthly reviews of contact details (Officer names and contacts) by administrative staff.

An Annual Exercise to test arrangements of the plan will be conducted by the Chief Executive Officer and reviewed by the L&DMG.

- 2.6 Bustiffres
- 2.7 Terrorism
- 2.8 Exotic Disease

2.1 STORMS

The whole of the Shire is at risk with the main concentration within the towns of St. George, Bollon, Dirranbandi, Thallon, Hebel and Mungindi. Storms <u>main</u>ly occur between October and March.

2.2 HAZARDOUS CHEMICAL ACCIDENTS

The potential exists for road accidents with resultant explosion, fire and public safety because of the quantities of dangerous chemicals, explosive fluids, gas and oil continually being moved throughout the Shire.

The oil/gas production and rigs have adequate inbuilt safety measures and have strict emergency procedures should an incident occur.

Underground pipelines are adequately marked. HazChem storage may occur at several sites within the Shire however, the risk of impact damage to storage containers is minimal.

2.3 ROAD ACCIDENTS

Passenger omnibus road accidents could occur on any major road.

Wet weather conditions make the road shoulders and unsealed roads extremely dangerous.

2.4 AIRCRAFT ACCIDENTS

Balonne Shire Council owns and operates a number of Aerodromes and with the large number of private and commercial aircraft in the area the possibility of an aircraft accident is moderately high.

2.5 FLOODS

Although flooding occurs mainly during the period December to March, it can occur at any time of the year.

Flooding in this area may occur from flood rains falling in areas outside the Balonne Shire boundaries.

2.6 BUSHFIRES

The whole Shire is at risk following a wet season.

The main risk period is from September to the next wet.

2.7 TERRORISM

Terrorism is considered a low risk at this point of time, however there is a need to plan for the consequences of such an event.

2.8 EXOTIC DISEASES

There are a large number of cattle and sheep properties and also a large feral pig population within the Shire. Coupled with the number of road transports carrying livestock throughout the Shire, the potential exists for rapid spread of exotic animal disease.

Urgent and stringent centrol measures would be implemented by the responsible government agencies.

5. PRINCIPAL COMBATING AGENCIES

The organisations listed under Clause 9 - Operational Plan have accepted responsibility for the control of operations associated with each threat.

Organisations with a supporting role for each threat have also been identified under **Clause 9** – **Operational Plan**.

The principle Combating Agency shall notify the Chief Executive Officer, Balonne shire Council, who will act as Communications Officer if necessary during any activation of this plan.

Referatso to the State Rescue Policy Guidelines, a copy of which is attached at Appendix A.

6. CONCEPT OF OPERATIONS

Efficient command and control is the essential pre-requisite to the successful co-ordination of resources in Counter Disaster operations.

The successful exercise of command and control depends on:-

An easily identifiable command structure.

Reliable communications.

Accurate operating procedures and training.

Accurate and timely information, including the collection, collation and dissemination of operational information.

An efficient, well organised and well laid out operational headquarters.

Good administration.

In order to achieve efficient co-ordination of support for disaster operations, an DISASTER CO-ORDINATION CENTER (DCC) will be established at the Health Planning & Environment Department, Balonne Shire Council Chambers, Cnr. Victoria and Grey Streets, St. George, Telephone (07)46208844 Facsimile (07)46208845, or alternate site will be Council Depot, Grey Street, St George Telephone (07) 46208855 Facsimile (07) 46208856.

Any support required by the Control Authority upon implementation of this plan will be co-ordinated by the DCC.

The DCC is responsible for:-

Assistance in co-ordination of operations as defined in the plan.

Dissemination of public information through the appropriate media outlets.

Co-ordination with, and reporting to, district and state agencies.

The DCC shall be staffed primarily by Local Government personnel who are trained in the various aspects of headquarters operations.



Normally the staff of the DDC will comprise:-

(A)	Local Controller SES	(E)	Administration Officer

Provision is to be made for relief personnel capable of operating in various roles on a shift basis should this become necessary.

The Executive Officer (XO) and the senior officer from each of the primary or support agencies (or delegates), shall conduct the Counter-Disaster operation from the DCC in accordance with the Local Government Counter-Disaster Plan.

However, at the request of the appropriate activating authority, the DCC may be established by the SES for incidents which do not require implementation of the D M. Plan - eg missing person, searches, trail damage, vehicle accidents etc.

The procedures set out in the flow chart apply for major events only.

Statutory Authorities may request support for incidents and small-scale events, by making the request direct to the appropriate organisation.



8. **COMMUNICATIONS**

For major activations as per the respective explans, each participating agency will send a liaison officer to the DCC with autonomous communications to the parent agency, with the exception of the media, who will be placed on standby.


All requests for assistance must go through the DCC. Failure to do so may result in duplication of requests, or breakdowns in commands and co-ordination, resulting in no assistance being provided.

Contact telephone numbers for response organisations and key appointments are as shown in the attached.

Local radio may be used for announcements to the public and Disaster Management personnel as detailed in the relevant sub-plans, public education and public information.

Duty Statements - Disaster Coordination Centre Personnel

Executive Officer - Dutles include:

- Establishing and maintaining the Coordination Centre in a state of operational readiness;
- Prepares and implements Standard Operating Procedures governing the activation and conduct of the Disaster Coordination Centre;
- Provide trained staff to operate the Disaster Coordination Centre on a continuous basis;
- Identify and provide adequate resources to enable the Coordination Centre to operate efficiently;
- Oversee the processing of operational information;
- Establish and maintain administrative and financial systems for resources and monies expended in connection with the operation;
- Overview the preparation of Situation reports for presentation to the Disaster District Coordinator;
- Prepare materials for briefing and debriefing sessions;
- Prepare and conduct Local Government Counter Disaster Exercises.

It is essential that Executive Officers:

- Focus on the consequences of the impact as well as the operational aspects;
- · Maintain liaison with the Disaster District Coordinator;
- Delegate to avoid getting bogged down in micro management.
- Consider the big picture and keep abreast of the operational overview.

Administration Officer - Duties Include:

The Administration Officer is responsible for the overall physical management of the Disaster Coordination Centre during operations. Duties include:

- Ensure sufficient trained personnel are available to staff the Disaster Coordination Centre;
- Preparation of a Disaster Coordination Centre Duty Roster.
- Provide appropriate resources to enable the Disaster Coordination Centre to function:
- Furniture and Equipment (fax, photocopier, phones etc);
- Whiteboards;
- Maps and other reference material;
- Stationery:
- Meals and refreshments.
- Ensure a Register of Financial Expenditure and Equipment Resources expended during operations is maintained;
- · Provide security and cleaning for the Centre;
- Assist in monitoring the overall operation of the Disaster Coordination Centre.

Media Liaison Officer - Duties Include:

The Media Liaison Officer is responsible for the Management of all media matters relating to the Counter Disaster operations in the Local Government area of responsibility. The Media Liaison Officer's duties include:

- Preparing accurate Media Releases based on local operations;
- · Answering inquiries from all media sources;
- Maintaining a working log of press releases and all other significant contacts with media sources;
- Referring all media inquiries regarding political or controversial issues to the Chair of the Counter Disaster Committee;
- · Coordinating and manage all media interviews;
- Keeping abreast of the operational developments by liaison with the Intelligence Section;
- Maintaining a current contact register of media organisations;
- Utilising media to ensure timely and accurate dissemination of disaster information to the public; at one location and away from the Coordination Centre. Reimbursing the security of the Coordination Centre.

Communications Officer - Duties Include:

The Communications Officer is responsible for providing and maintaining all communications equipment within the Coordination Centre and providing advice to the Executive Officer on all communications matters during the operations. The Communications Officer duties include:

- The installation and maintenance of relevant communications and facsimile equipment within the Coordination Centre:
- Identifying systems faults and provide advice on alternative communications;
- Supervision of communications operators during operations;
- · Liaising with and advise the Executive Officer on operational communication matters;
- On completion of the operations, evaluating communication equipment performance and operational performance and resolve any deficiencies;
- Providing the Executive Officer with an evaluation report.

Intelligence Officer - Duties Include:

Staff situated with Intelligence can include an Intelligence Officer and Plotting Clerks.

The Intelligence Officer duties can include:

- Providing the Executive Officer with an accurate, timely, clear and concise picture of the situation, particularly regarding casualties and damage;
- Drafting the Situation Reports for the Executive Officer as required;
- · Screening operational information received or dispatched and interpret the actions as required;
- Ensuring the overall situation is accurately depicted on maps, charts and display boards;
- Forecasting of any other threat etc.



Telephone Operators - Duties Include:

The telephonists are responsible for receiving and transmitting information by telephone in the Coordination Centre. Their duties include:

Answering incoming telephone calls and accurately recording the information on the appropriate form.

Ensuring all recorded information is passed to the Logging Officer.

Liaison Officers - Duties Include

The Liaison Officers represent/agencies providing support. They may include some or the entire emergency services plus the support services or agencies.

Liaison Officers in a Disaster Coordination Centre need to:

Facilitate the provision of their agency's resources;

Continue to advise their parent agency of developing plans and the likely effect on resource commitment; and

Communicate with their parent agency to receive up to date information on the availability of resources for

tasking, pass on tasking directions and to receive advice on completion of tasks.
